I wanted to give you an update on the most recent 'Emergency Order' Based on the most recent Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS) Emergency Order (EO) and the MDHHS Interim Guidance For Athletics, effective Friday, April 2, 2021, 'weekly testing is required for individuals ages 13-19 who participate in athletics. The current Emergency Order remains in effect through April 19, 2021.

The new order requires athletes to complete a COVID test prior to any event. What this means, all participants of the Academic Showcase must be complete a COVID Test no more than a week before the showcase.

We want your athlete to participate in this event. Here are a few options

1. Take a COVID test near you.
2. If you are participating in a Spring Sport or 7-on-7, you can use the same results for this event.

Q: Is weekly testing required?

A: Yes, based on the current MDHHS Emergency Order. But the testing is used only for our 1 day event.

Q: Where will the testing be held at the event or complex?

A: No. All testing must be done prior to arriving to the event. We will perform temperature checks on the athletes.

Q: Are their testing centers nearby?

A: Yes, there are several centers nearby offering Rapid testing.
